

## **ALPHA UPDATE**

As per last week's Alpha announcement, here is Tip #3 for inviting people to Alpha but first let's look back at tips one and two.

## Tip 1

Pause and pray – remember we are collaborating with the Holy Spirit in this endeavour.

## Tip 2

Customize your conversation – there's no one size fits all conversation

## TIP #3: Be specific and direct

We often invite people to something without them really knowing it's an invitation. Consider how many times plans have been made to "hang out sometime" with someone, and it never happens. Asking a yes or no question will get a yes or no answer. Provide specific details so they can make an informed decision.

For example, avoid starting with a vague inquiry like, "Are you doing anything Wednesday evening?" Those questions put people on guard and can lead to resentment if they feel backed into a corner. They may prefer to do nothing rather than join you ... and that's ok! Instead, just ask if they would like to join you on Wednesday for a meal, video presentation and small group discussion where they need not say a word if the choose.
